

State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) – Notice of Surface Water Shortage for 2009

SWRCB has notified all diverters of surface water that in view of the current drought conditions that it is prudent to assume that there will **not** be sufficient surface water available during the year for those who hold water right permits, licenses, and registrations issued by the State Water Board. The SWRCB is stating that “If water supply conditions do not improve, permit, license and registration holders may be curtailed. It may even become necessary this year in some parts of the state to curtail more senior water rights, such as riparian rights or pre-1914 rights.”
