RESOLUTION 61697-3

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING REGULATIONS FOR THE PREVENTION OF WASTE AND UNREASONABLE USE OF WATER

WHEREAS, water, energy and treatment materials are conserved when water is conserved; and

WHEREAS, water is a vital natural resource, and as such, must be conserved and used wisely and reasonably, not only for the present generation, but future generations as well; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that a public program of water conservation be maintained within the District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Carmichael Water District that a "Five Point" Mandatory Conservation Program is hereby implemented to prevent the waste and unreasonable use of water:

1. Odd/Even Watering - 3 Day Per Week Schedule: Watering between Noon and 6:00 p.m. is prohibited. There is no outdoor watering on Monday. No customer shall waste water. Care shall be taken not to water past the point of saturation to prevent runoff. Water is not permitted to flow on sidewalks, driveways, streets or escape down a gutter, ditch or other drain.

Odd number addresses – Outdoor watering is limited to Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday
Even number addresses – Outdoor watering is limited to Wednesday, Friday and Sunday.
2. Hosing down paved surfaces is only allowed to alleviate immediate health or safety hazards.
3. Free flowing hoses are prohibited for any use. An automatic shutoff device is required on all hoses in use.
4. All swimming pools, spas, and ornamental fountains/pools using District water shall be equipped with a recirculation pump and maintained leak free. The "dump and fill" practice of pool maintenance is prohibited.
5. Restaurants are encouraged to serve water only upon customer request.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that water users found violating the requests of the District will be issued one warning, either written or verbal. Upon subsequent violation, the District shall have the right to disconnect service to said user, and require a restoration charge of \$50.00 for the 1st Reconnect Charge, \$75.00 for the 2nd Reconnect Charge, and \$100.00 for a 3rd Reconnect Charge. A 4th Reconnect Charge shall be \$100.00 plus the cost for installation of a Flow Restrictor, if, in the opinion of the General Manager, service should be restored. In any event of continued violation, the District shall have the right to install on the premises involved a device which will restrict the flow of District water to said premises. All expense incurred by the District for this installation shall be paid by the violator. Once installed, such device shall be removed only upon the order of the General Manager.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that existing policies in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.
