**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A VOLUNTARY
ACCELERATED RESIDENTIAL METER PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Carmichael Water District has received several requests from single family residential property owners to have a meter installed and be billed at a metered rate; and

WHEREAS, Carmichael Water District can accomplish the installation of 50 residential meters per year in conjunction with its regular metering program which will be phased over the next several years; and

WHEREAS, this Voluntary Accelerated Residential Metering Program can be implemented on a "first come, first served basis" with a cap of 50 voluntary meter installations per fiscal year (July 1 to June 30); and

WHEREAS, Carmichael Water District can publicize this program through its public information program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Carmichael Water District Board of Directors hereby adopts the following Voluntary Accelerated Residential Meter Program:

1. Carmichael Water District will install up to 50 Residential Water Meters per fiscal year for single family residential property owners who request to be billed on a metered basis.
2. Carmichael Water District will install meters at District expense on qualifying accounts on a "first come, first served" basis.
3. The schedule of installation will be established based upon the District's receipt of a signed "request for meter" application.
4. The installation schedule will be wholly dependent on the availability of District resources to facilitate the installation.
5. Once the property owner has requested installation of a meter, the decision to convert to a metered rate will not be subject to change.
